2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION SUMMARY

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN – CAUTION - May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. May cause eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid contact with open cuts or sores. Avoid breathing vapors. Use with adequate ventilation. Eye protection and gloves are suggested when handling undiluted product. Wash thoroughly after handling and using this product. In case of contact, flush with water. Get medical attention for eyes. This blended liquid fertilizer is derived from Anhydrous Ammonia, Urea Ammonium Nitrate Solution, Phosphoric Acid, and Zinc Sulfate. Nausea and vomiting could be expected upon large dose ingestion. The acute ingestive effects are described as nausea, chills, and diarrhea. Eye or skin contact with these products could cause irritation (particularly in sensitive persons), and respiratory irritation could be expected from the unprotected inhalation of fertilizer mists. Product users should avoid prolonged or repeated skin contact by wearing impervious gloves, long sleeve shirt, long pants, socks and rubber boots. Goggles for eye protection are recommended.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

STEPS TO BE TAKEN IF MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED:

Ventilate area. Contain spill, absorb liquid with clay or other absorbent material. Sweep up material and place in container for possible land application according to label use or for proper disposal. Check local, state and federal regulations for proper disposal.

CAUTION: Keep spills and cleaning runoff out of municipal sewers and open bodies of water.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

HANDLING: Avoid breathing fertilizer mists. Avoid prolonged or repeated skin contact. Avoid eye contact. Wash thoroughly after handling product and before eating, drinking, using the restroom or using tobacco.

STORAGE: Store in original containers only. Keep containers tightly closed when not in use. Store in a cool, dry well-ventilated area, preferably in a locked storage area away from children, feed and food products, and seed. Store at ambient temperatures. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
